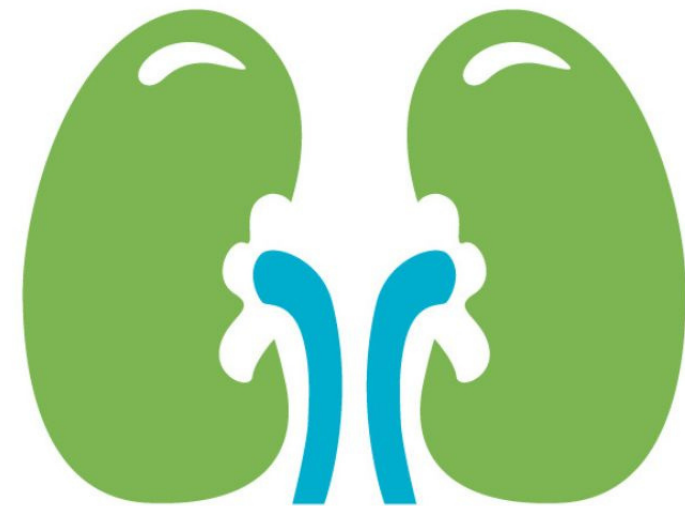


12 steps to GREEN A KIDNEY UNIT

5 Focus on acid concentrates

6 Save water

7 Reduce and decarbonise staff travel

8 Encourage patients to bring own blankets to dialysis

9 Move charitable and research accounts to greener banks

10 Consider carbon implications in procurement

11 Tackle prevention and tailor dialysis

12 Develop resilience/contingency plans
