

How to register with eLFH

The registration requirements have been made wider and wider over the years. See the support article here: <http://support.e-lfh.org.uk/get-started/registration/how-do-i-register/>.

Registration is open to everyone on the GDC register who does some NHS work and to non-dental practice staff, students and others:

- Dentists must provide their GDC number and the assumption is that they are on the Performer List (or else holding an NHS email address or at University Dental School)
- In the case of DCPs, they provide a performer number or else provide details of the practice they work in and a Practice Dentist there, who must be a performer.
- In the case of receptionists and other non-dental staff in surgeries, they must provide details of the practice they work in and a Practice Dentist there
- Students and those working at universities, along with independent providers carrying out work for the NHS and those working in prison healthcare (for example), can all access with their NHS England Open Athens account: <http://support.e-lfh.org.uk/get-started/openathens/>
- Dental Foundation Trainees are registered en masse every summer in advance of their training year commencing, as we are connected to the co-ordinators at all the Deaneries/regional HEE offices
