

The agreement at COP 21 in Paris was the result of a remarkable coalition of forces, interacting with political leadership globally. By COP 22 in Marrakesh, November 2016, it will be possible to start judging progress in implementing the agreement. Collaboration will need to strengthen, accelerate and become more sophisticated, if we are to alleviate climate disaster. All of us in the climate movement need to be aware of the human as well as organisational elements in that collective process.
