The Green Week is aimed for healthcare staff to gain an understanding of the NHS sustainability agenda, meet sustainability experts working with the NHS and hear from Trusts that have benefited from sustainability projects.

From clean air to the cost-of-living crisis, we know that the climate emergency is a health emergency. We experience it as people, as we live our lives, and we share it as leaders across the NHS.
